House of Hemmant 2022 Blanc de Blanc

Varietal: 100% Chardonnay

Notes: A sparkling wine showcasing exceptional

finesse. Crafted in the traditional Champagne method with secondary fermentation in the bottle, this dry wine highlights the clean, crisp, and linear profile of unoaked Chardonnay. On the palate, vibrant apple, pear, and lemon zest flavours are complemented by a delicate hint of brioche, offering a refreshing and balanced finish.

Pairing Suggestions: with canapés, oysters, smoked salmon, quail eggs or asparagus.

Skylark 2022 Brut

Varietal: Phoenix & Seyval Blanc

Notes: A crisp, dry white sparkling wine made using the traditional fermentation

method, which adds layers of depth and complexity. The wine opens with vibrant aromas of apple, melon, and white peach, followed by hints of apricot, guava, and elderflower. A delicate toastiness completes the profile. Crafted in South Norfolk from a blend of Phoenix and Seyval Blanc grapes, this wine offers a refreshing and elegant experience—a true reflection of Norfolk's terroir.

Pairing Suggestions: perfect for celebrations. Drink on its own or with canapés.

Varietal: Pinot Noir & Pinot

Meunier

Notes: A delicately crafted traditional method sparkling wine, showcasing a beautiful rose gold hue. On the nose, crisp red apple and vibrant wild strawberry aromas mingle with subtle slate minerality. The palate offers an elegant mouthfeel, with bright, fresh fruit notes that lead into a long, refined finish.

Pairing Suggestions: with canapes, salmon, patés or summer fruits.

Skylark 2022 Demi Sec

Varietal: Phoenix & Seyval

Blanc

Notes: An off-dry sparkling wine crafted usina traditional Champaign method.

This wine offers a delightful balance of honeyed notes, baked apple, melon, and pineapple, with a touch of brioche toastiness. A perfect choice for celebrations, it combines fruit-forward richness with elegant complexity.

Pairing Suggestions: Drink alfresco; equally at home with fruit-sweetened desserts or Afternoon Tea.

Red Kite 2022

Varietal: 100% Regent

Notes: A rare red sparkling wine made from the Regent grape, expertly crafted using

the traditional method. This dry, light red wine is brimming with bright red fruit flavours of cranberry, cherry, and strawberry, perfectly balanced by the gentle yeast character from secondary fermentation in the bottle, adding depth and complexity.

Pairing Suggestions: with BBQ meats or Sunday Roast with cranberry sauce.

Siskin 2022

Varietal: Solaris Blend

Notes: The Siskin is a sustainably crafted artisan dry white made from the Solaris grape. After a

two-day maceration and gentle pressing, it undergoes sequential malolactic fermentation, which imparts a smooth, creamy texture. The wine offers a refreshing character of apple, pear, lemon, and melon, balancing crispness with a rich mouth feel.

Pairing suggestions: Pasta, smoked fish or a variety of cheeses for an elevated dining experience that highlights its vibrant character.

Redwing 2023

Varietal: Pinot Noir & Regent

Notes: A Provence-inspired blush dry rosé, lightly pressed to preserve its delicate character. Crisp apple and

citrus aromas are complemented by subtle hazelnut and vibrant red fruit flavours, including ripe strawberries. The wine offers a refreshing balance with a smooth, dry finish.

Pairing suggestions: chicken salad, smoked fish and light nutty cheeses.

Swift 2023

Varietal: 100% Schönburger

Notes: Lightly pressed and cool fermented to preserve its vibrant fruity aromatics, this wine reveals its heritage with a light Muscat fruitiness,

complemented by delicate floral notes of honeysuckle, elderflower and rose. Pronounced flavours of lychee, lemon, and quince emerge on the palate, offering a fresh and aromatic experience.

Pairing suggestions: Asian curries or grilled fish.

Robin Redbreast 2023

Varietal: 100% Cabernet Noir

Notes: A light red wine made from the Swiss Cabernet Noir grape, lightly pressed and undergoing malolactic fermentation. The wine

features gently integrated tannins, showcasing the vibrant mulberry, red currant, and raspberry character of the grape.

Pairing suggestions: Roast duck, pork medallions or summer salads.

Chaffinch 2023

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Notes: Light ruby red, yet bursting with flavour, this wine reveals delicate red cherry, juicy blackberry, and damson plum notes. Subtle

hints of gun smoke, cedar, vanilla, and white pepper add depth, imparted from oak contact.

Pairing suggestions: Smoked salmon or a Sunday roast.
